

Report of the Internal complaints Committee Meeting cum Awareness Programme in Kidderpore College

The **Internal Complaints Committee of Kidderpore College** organised a meeting cum Awareness programme on Sexual Harassment in Higher Education Institutions in collaboration with the IQAC on 6.12.2022 at 12.00 noon. Eminent Lawyer and External Member ICC Advocate Shelly Sarkar and Gender Trainer Cum Women's Rights Activist Smt. Sukanya Kar were present as the resource persons. In the meeting cum awareness programme the guidelines of the Prevention and Prohibition of Sexual Harassment Against Women at Workplace Act were explained and how the process of lodging complaints and redressal of complaints through this Cell can proceed was explained in details. The meeting was followed by an awareness programme organised by the Women's Forum, Kidderpore college on Communal Harmony and Women's Rights. The **Women's Forum** also acts as a platform for the redressal of grievances put forward by the female students as well as the college staff.

Minutes of the Meeting:

1. It was decided that if any female student of the college or any female staff of the college faced any problem relating to sexual harassment inside the college premises she can bring the matter for redressal before the ICC.
2. It was also decided that if any female student or any female staff faced any problem other than sexual harassment that matter can also be brought before the ICC.

3. It was decided that the Women's forum will assist the ICC in all its deliberations.

4. It was decided that from then onwards meetings of the ICC will be conducted at regular intervals.

5. It was also decided that from time to time awareness cum sensitisation programmes will be organised by the ICC in collaboration with the Human Rights Organisations and the NGOs working in the interest of women's rights.

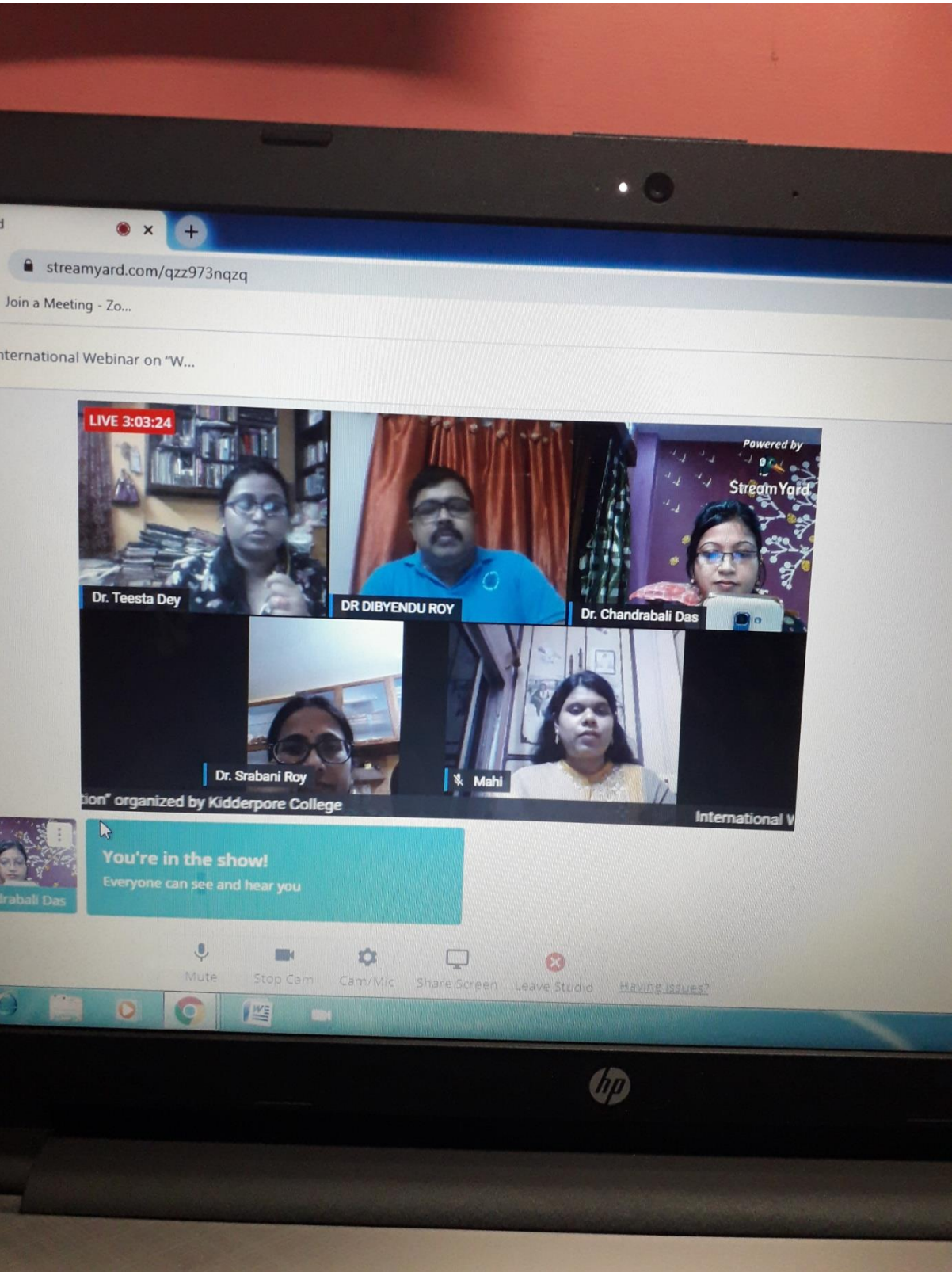


Kidderpore College Women's Forum organises International Webinar on the Theme: Women's Empowerment and the Present Generation

On 18.09.2020 Kidderpore College Women's Forum organised an International Webinar on the theme "Women's Empowerment and The Present Generation". Every year on the 8th of March the Women's Forum organises a host of programmes to mark the International Women's Day. But this year due to the outbreak of the Covid Pandemic and the sudden announcement of nationwide lockdown by the Government of India the Women's Forum could not organise any such programme. Nevertheless the Forum organised the Webinar as a mark of respect towards the women folk all over the world.

Two eminent speakers were invited as Resource Persons in the Webinar. The first speaker was Prof. Umme Farhana, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Jatiyo Kabi Kazi Nazrul Islam University, Mymensingh, Bangladesh. The theme of the seminar was **DigitALL: Innovation And Technology For Gender equality**.
