
Analysis:

 Out of total 52 responses 63.5 % teachers were agreed that current content of syllabus (CBCS) is need based & up to date, with focus on contemporary development.




Out of total 52 responses 55.8 % teachers were agreed the depth of course content is adequate to have significant learning outcomes.




3. Analysis: 44.2 % teachers were disagreed Out of total 52 responses that the syllabus is compatible & well distributed within the limited time frame of the semester system.




4. Analysis: Out of total 52 responses 36.5% teachers were disagreed that sufficient reference materials & books are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus.






Analysis: 77.9 % guardians agree that college and its environment has transformed the personality of their children's ward.

Analysis: 73.5 % Parents like to assist with teachers for better future development of students. They want greater cooperation and better functioning of the college.




Q 1. Did the syllabus taught to you helped you in the development of your personality and met the challenges you faced in terms of learning values, skills and real-life situations?


Q 2. Were you satisfied with the access to books and reading materials available in the College library?


Equal percentage of students strongly agree and agree with the access to books and reading materials were available in the college library.

Q 3. The Syllabus adequately addressed current events, world problems, and studies relating to national and international trends.




Analysis: 48.1% students strongly agree that the syllabus adequately addressed current events, world problems and studies relating to national and international trends.

Q 4. The College Library and Study Materials were sufficient and there was no need to visit other libraries?





Q 5. The syllabus helped you to get into higher studies and provided opportunities in terms of employment and Entrepreneurship?






Analysis: 96% students believes that the course developed social skills.






Analysis: 42.9 % employees agree that the course curriculum as prescribed by the University of Calcutta imparted soft skills to employee.






