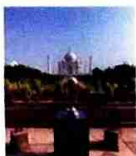

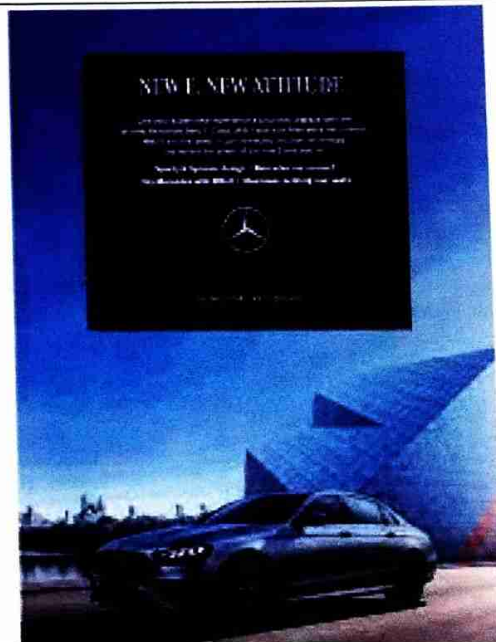
### India's wrestling issue reaches global platform

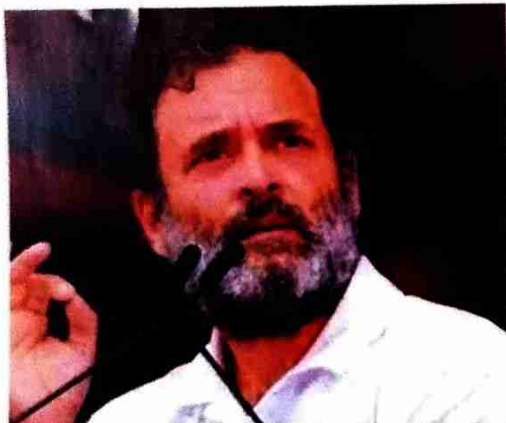

### Rahul Gandhi loses MP seat



Top Congress leader Rahul Gandhi has been disqualified as a member of India's lower house of Parliament, the Lok Sabha, who was elected as an MP from Wayanad. After being convicted of defamation over his remarks about Prime Minister. The decision comes only a day after Surat Court declared him to two years in prison. It has granted him bail and suspended the sentence for 30 days to allow him to appeal in a higher court. A notice issued by the Lok Sabha and sentenced him to two years prison according to the Indian

law. According to the section 8 of the representation of the people Act, 1951 Rahul Gandhi will continue to be ineligible to serve in the Lok Sabha and be prohibited from running in any election for total eight years. But he won't go to jail immediately because the court granted him bail for 30 days to file appeal against the verdict. If an appeal set aside Rahul Gandhi conviction he can get back his seat back. Many leaders blocked proceedings in Parliament on Friday and later tried to March to the Presidents' palace in support of Rahul

Gandhi holding a sign that read "Democracy in danger" and said the country is witnessing a rule of autocracy said a Raj, an opposition law maker. The conviction came in a case relating to a speech that Rahul Gandhi, then the president of India's main opposition party, the Congress, had made at an election rally while campaigning in Karnataka for the 2019 parliamentary election. Targeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi for alleged corruption, Gandhi made a dig at his last, which he compare with escapee billionaire entrepreneur Nirav Modi and Lalit Modi (who has no relation with the prime minister). Rahul Gandhi mentioned that "Why do all thieves share the Modi surname?" Gandhi asked at the rally. After being convicted by Surat Court Rahul Gandhi says - "My religion is based on Non - Violence, Truth is my god. India's criminal defamation law provides for a maximum term of two years of simple imprisonment or a fine or both. Critics of the law point out that it is antidemocratic as it curbs free speech. Besides, it is used as an instrument to harass political rivals and silence them.

### Kolkata Metro makes history



India is going to introduce the country's first underground metro train in Kolkata. This would be one of the biggest achievements of our country in the field of transport. On Wednesday Kolkata Metro created history as it successfully conducted its Howrah maiden run through tunnel under Hooghly river. Metro rail general manager P Uday Kumar Reddy travelled from Mahakaran to Howrah maiden station. The Kolkata Metro was initially planned in the 1920s, but construction started in the 1970s. The making of this underwater tunnel was not an easy job as the planning and the designing of this tunnel took approximately 360 words and the Kolkata metro rail corporation conducted research in 13 countries that are experts in underwa-

ter techniques. The project will also link the Esplanade station of the Kolkata metro's north-south line with the railway stations in Howrah and Sealdah and also this metro route is spread from Salt Lake sector 5 to salt lake stadium, there will be metro station at Karunamayee, Central park, city center and Bengal chemical. Once operational, this will be the deepest metro station (33 meters below the surface) in India. It will cover a distance of 520- meter under Hooghly river in 45 second. Addition GM, Metro Railway and Kolkata Metro Rail Cmaiden to Esplanade and it is also said that underwater tunnels are as deep as the length of a 10 floor building and the making of these tunnels was a challenging job for the engineers.

## Modi: New agreements for Australia



Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi struck new agreements Wednesday with his Australian counterpart Anthony Albanese on migration and green hydrogen, while raising concerns about attacks on Hindu temples.

Modi was welcomed Tuesday by around 20,000 cheering fans, many chanting "Modi," at a Sydney stadium for his second visit to Australia as India's leader. But his visit has also been protested by activists who accuse his government of restricting Muslim and other minorities' rights, as well as press freedom. Anti-Modi posters appeared around Sydney, and Hindu temples in Sydney's west were recently vandalized. Sikhs have also used the visit to demand a separate state. Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese praised on Indian counterpart Narendra Modi, likening him to American rock star Bruce Springsteen in a gushing introductory speech at a stadium on last Tuesday. Modi is making his first visit to Sydney in nine years

as he gears up to contest national elections next year – and as Australia looks to build economic bridges with the world's most populous market at a time when relations with another Asian giant, China, have soured. Standing on stage at the Qudos Bank Arena on Tuesday, a sprawling entertainment venue in the city's Olympic Park, Albanese played emcee and warm up act. "The last time I saw someone on the stage here was Bruce Springsteen, and he didn't get the welcome that Prime Minister Modi has got," Albanese said. "You have brought the spirit of the world's biggest democracy to Australia," Albanese said of his "dear friend," adding the Indian leader has helped strengthen Australia's democracy. "Prime Minister Modi is the boss!" he added, to thunderous applause from a crowd dominated by Australians. Originally planned as a summit for leaders from the Quad, which includes the United States and Japan, Modi's trip to Australia comes as Canberra is trying to bolster its relationship

with New Delhi in a bid to grow economic ties and reinforce their strategic partnership, as the West attempts to thwart the rise of an increasingly assertive China. "In the language of cricket, our ties have entered the T20 mode," Modi said during a joint appearance with Albanese. The deal will "promote the two-way mobility of students, graduates, academic researchers and business people, while also enhancing cooperation to prevent irregular migration and people smuggling", the partners said. A new Centre for Australia-India Relations, that will act as national platform to bring government together with industry, academia and the community. The meeting is the sixth time Albanese has met Modi in his first year as leader of Australia and it built on the outcomes from the Australia-India Annual Leaders' Summit in March, government noted. Australia is a better place because of the contributions of Indian-Australian community, and we want to see more connections between our countries

## India's two academy awards

The Academy Awards, better known as the Oscar are the Hollywood's most prestigious honours for artistic and technical merit for the global film industry. The various category winners are awarded with this international Academic Award. The golden statuette as a trophy officially called the "Academy Award of Merit", although it's more commonly referred by its nickname Oscar (Occupation Skills Competition And Review). The Academy Award schedule held on 12 March, Sunday at the Dolby Theatre at Ovation Hollywood. In the 95th Academy Award which held in Los Angeles, India grabbed 2 Oscar one for the best original song for "NAATU NAATU" from the blockbuster South Indian Film "RRR" and Best Documentary category for the short film "THE ELEPHANT WHISPERER". This is the first time two India-made production won two international prize. Dancer



cum Model and Actress Lauren Gottlieb set the Oscar stage on fire with her mesmerizing moves on the hook step of the telegu track. Performing at the Academy Awards was an experience for a lifetime of Gottlieb. Deepika Padukone introduced the song with loud cheers. Australia Crowned as new ICC World Test Champions- The ICC World Test Championship is played by the best global cricket teams, who all



compete to win the trophy for the world's premier Test cricket tournament., securing a resounding 209-run victory over India in the thrilling ICC World Test Championship Final 2023 at The Oval. Australia Crowned ICC World Test Championship 2023 Australia clinched the title of World Test Champions in a commanding fashion, securing a resounding 209-run victory over India in the thrilling WTC Final at The Oval. Travis Head and Steve Smith's remarkable centuries in the first innings laid the foundation for Australia's early control of the Test. Despite India's valiant response, the match extended to a fifth day, but they fell short of an

extraordinary record chase, ultimately being bowled out for 234. Australia scripted history on Sunday, June 11 as they became the first men's

team in world cricket to win an International Cricket Council (ICC) world title in all three formats. Travis Head (163 off 174 balls in 1st innings, 18 off 27 balls in 2nd innings). Australia won the ICC Test Championship mace for the first time, and were also awarded the cash prize of US\$1.6 million, while India won US\$800,000. Accompanied by the contributions of Nathan Lyon and Mitchell Starc, Australia systematically dismantled India's batting lineup, ultimately clinching the title. Nathan Lyon's stellar performance throughout the Test Championship made him the highest wicket-taker in the world. Australian Batsmen Shine Bright in ICC World Test Championship Cycle Australia's dominance in the WTC cycle was bolstered by their formidable batting lineup, with four of their top six run-scorers featuring prominently in the rankings. Usman Khawaja and Marnus Labuschagne showcased their prowess, accumulating an impressive tally of runs, with only Joe Root surpassing them in scoring. Furthermore, Travis Head and Steve Smith, the heroes of the first innings in the WTC Final, displayed their consistency throughout the Championship, contributing significantly with 1407 and 1389 runs respectively.

### CSK won 16th IPL title



Chennai super kings (CSK) won their fifth Indian premier league (IPL) title by defeating the reigning champions Gujarat Titans (GT) led by Hardik Pandya by five wickets in the finals of the 16th edition of IPL (IPL 2023) at Narendra Modi stadium (the largest cricket stadium in the world) in sardar vallabhai patel sport complex, Ahmedbad Gujarat. Devon Conway and Ruturaj Gaikwad have been spearheading the CSK batting at the top. Devon Conway has scored 625 runs in the 14 innings this season batting with a strike rate of 137 and on a strike rate of 146. Chennai super kings have now equaled Mumbai Indians' record for five IPL titles. MS Dhoni who was leading in his 10th IPL final, has also drawn level with Rohit Sharma- both men now have five IPL titles as captain. It was Chennai's fifth IPL title as they now join Mumbai Indians to share the

record for the most IPL trophies by a team. Under the leadership of Rohit Sharma, team MI bagged the title in 2013, 2015, 2017, 2019, and 2020, while CSK won the trophy in 2010, 2011, 2018, 2021, and 2023 under Dhoni's captaincy. "Where Dhoni seemed to believe he had one more season of triumph left for his fans. This is the best time to announce my retirement," he said. "He however, said he'd give it a few more months because of the amount of love and affection I have been shown wherever I have been this year," Dhoni said. "he'd likely come back and play at least one more season of the IPL as a gift" from his said to the fans. "The way they've shown their love and affection, I think that's something I need to do for them," he said.

### Isro's latest launch: LVM 3



The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will supervise the second blast off of India's largest rocket, LVM3, from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota on Sunday. This rocket is also referred to as "OneWeb India-2 Mission". The

LVM3-M3/OneWeb India-2 Mission overall and its second mission to Low Earth orbit (between 400-2000 km above earth). The vehicle took off with a total payload of 5,805kg at 09:00:20 hours local time from the second launch pad at SDSC-

SHAR, Sriharikota. It gained the required altitude of 450 km in about nine minutes of flight, achieved satellite injection conditions in the eighteen minute, and began injecting the satellite in the twentieth minute. The C25 stage performed a sophisticated maneuver to repeatedly orient itself in orthogonal directions and inject satellite into precise orbits with defined timegaps to avoid collision of the satellites. 367 satellites were separated in 9 phases, in a batch of 4. OneWeb confirmed the acquisition of signals from all 36 satellites. The mission marked OneWeb's second satellite deployment from India, highlighting the strong partnership with NSIL and ISRO. It was OneWeb's 18th launch bringing the total of OneWeb's constellation to 618 satellites. Calling the launch LVM3 M2 a historic event, Shri S. Somnath, Chairman, ISRO lauded the synergistic efforts between ISRO, NSIL, OneWeb in realizing the mission in a record time. He specifically acknowledged the design and development of an interplanetary navigation system at LPSC for C25 operations. This was one of the biggest commercial orders executed by ISRO. With this launch, the LVM3 enters into global market in a grand manner.
